## **OUCH Treasurer's Report 2012:**

This has been a time for financial propriety and careful management, being as we are in yet another year of austerity. In spite of this the Treasurers report for the OUCH organisation is not a gloomy one. I can confirm that we have a determined starting balance and limited expenses.

Our celebratory cake making efforts (supplies) have been precisely sponsored by philanthropic efforts and donations (fundraising) and have not made any unusual demands on club finances. Baked celebrations have coincided with endowments for more than one centenarian but international transfer fees and fees gathered from new members has been used to offset. Profits earned have been reinvested so no tax is due.
